THE JEKYLL ISLAND CLUB HOTEL FOR THE ROMANTIC GETAWAY

Originally a hunting retreat for the nation's wealthy elite, the Hotel today is the resort of choice for those seeking a relaxing, romantic getaway.

The Hotel, located on the intra coastal side of the island, is near the Jekyll Wharf where millionaires as early as 1888 arrived aboard their yachts to enjoy the "season." The drive to the front of the Hotel curves through live oaks and magnolia trees where horse drawn carriages are available for moonlight rides. As guests arrive, friendly bellmen greet them with enthusiasm, giving the first indication of the high level of service they will receive at this resort.

The center of a 240-acre historic village, the Hotel is American Queen Ann style of architecture. Its distinctive turret, bay windows, and verandas set it apart as do its superior view of the lawns, intra coastal waterway, and vast marshlands. The 157 rooms and suites in five distinctive settings, are appointed with period reproductions and offer the utmost in convenient, comfortable lodging.

Honeymooners and couples celebrating anniversaries may prefer the hotel's Presidential Suite as a special treat. There is simply nothing else like it. Recently redecorated, the suite's intimate Victorian parlor opens through double wooden doors to the spacious bedroom. Each room has a cozy fireplace where a fire can be prepared on cool evenings. The luxurious bathroom features a large Jacuzzi and separate shower. A spiral staircase leads to the turret with its antique brass telescope for stargazing. It is romantic.

All the rooms and suites in the hotel have recently been renovated; new interior designs are charming. Reflecting the “life of elegant leisure” and ambience of an earlier time, they also have the conveniences and amenities that meet the expectations of today’s travelers.

Dinner for two in the Grand Dining Room is a memorable experience. Ionic columns border the central walkway leading to a large, elegant Victorian fireplace. Expansive windows provide a handsome view, while candlelight and soft music complete the ambience. Our chef is available to prepare continental and low-country specialties tableside for two. On jasmine-scented, warmer nights, dining alfresco at the Courtyard at Crane restaurant is a delightful experience. As the fountain provides background music, it’s easy to imagine Tuscany in the arcaded loggia of this Italian Renaissance style courtyard. . . pure romance.

The nearly Olympic size swimming pool is one of many hotel amenities including a putting green, 22 miles of flat bicycle paths, and tournament level croquet. Nearby are three 18-hole golf courses and boat charters for inshore or offshore fishing. Enjoy a romantic walk along the beach to bask in sea breezes or watch the sun rise. Or, step back in time with an amble through the historic area which surrounds the Hotel. Liveoak trees festooned with Spanish moss border the pathways through lawns and gardens of houses built a century ago. Some prefer to see the historic village by horse drawn carriage.
